

OSP looks for hit and run suspect

TILLAMOOK – A hit-and-run crash on Highway 6 left several people seriously injured just east of Tillamook and now police want to find the suspect.

Oregon State Police say Saturday night when a van rear-ended with a car, sending it into the eastbound lanes. That when the car collided with another car. After the crash the van fled the scene. Later, found the van abandoned about a mile down the road.

The driver of the first car, 55-year-old Steven Kershaw, had only minor injuries, but his wife was critically hurt. Their daughter, also in the car, received only minor injuries. There were four people in the second car and most of them had serious injuries.
