

Beaverton man arrested in connection with shooting

A 24-year-old Beaverton man has been arrested and accused of attempted murder in connection with a Sunday morning shooting at Browns Camp in Western Washington County.

Scott Clem was lodged in the Washington County Jail, according to the Washington County Sheriff's Department.

Deputies were called to the camp shortly after 5 a.m. Sunday. They found that Raymond Robinson, 47, of Hillsboro had been shot three times and the suspect had left the scene.

Robinson and the suspect, deputies learned, had been camping together with other friends. Robinson told deputies the suspect called his name and then shot him. Robinson was taken to Oregon Health & Science University.

An investigation is underway.
